

OBJECTIVE: To provide a framework for all members of the project team to guide their approach, actions, and decision-making related to the Project

- Deliver mission-critical features before nice to have features.
- 2. Communicate with our system users and stakeholders; carefully consider and respond to their assessments and concerns.
- 3. Invest in our people as we undergo organizational change and acknowledge they are essential to the success of the project.
- 4. Emphasize quality and ensure project timelines are met while making necessary course corrections promptly.
- Use project management controls to steer the project and direct participants.
- Adequately staff the project while we maintain sufficient staffing for the program's business needs.
- 7. Emphasize importance of results delivered and accepted and conform contracts to meet these requirements.
- 8. Test early and often to identify and fix problems.
- Develop and execute a sound and proven implementation strategy.
- 10. Use functionality from the transfer system unless there are compelling reasons to modify.

Maximus (PMO).


#### DDI begins work

In March 2022 the DDI team begins work to transfer the FL CAMS, an SAP system, to IL. BPR work and pre-JADs begin.


#### TIS kicks off


The team begins work on the initial planning documents and begins work on the Business Process Documentation, Learning Management System and Training Delivery.
